I am truly delighted to summarize my stay at the thermodynamic center and the department of science from Osaka University, as a visiting professor during March 2020.

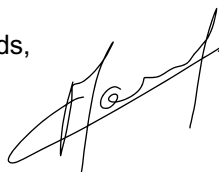
First, it was a great honor to receive your invitation after our meeting at the Calcon Conference 2019 held in Santa Fe (USA).
